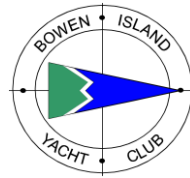

Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. Boats will be scored according to the rules of PHRF BC.
- 1.3. Courtesy ORC scoring will be provided for boats that supply ORC ratings.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The race is open to self-righting cruising class boats, multihulls, and sport boats.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form found at <http://www.biyc.bc.ca/wordpress/racing/round-bowen-race/>.
- 2.3. Online registration will be accepted until 2000 on Friday June 7, 2019
- 2.4. In person registration will be accepted at Race Headquarters until 2000 hours on Friday, June 7, 2019.

3. FEES

- 3.1. Early registration fees received on or before June 1, 2019 are \$55 CAD.
- 3.2. Registration fees received on or after June 1, 2019 are \$65 CAD.
- 3.3. Fees include rafting moorage for Friday and Saturday nights.

0950 hours Start Sequence

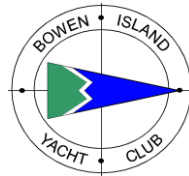
1730 hours No finish will be recorded after this time.

5. RATINGS

Each boat shall declare its BC PHRF rating at registration. The regatta committee will assign ratings to boats without PHRF ratings as necessary.

- Div 1 PHRF < 60
- Div 2 PHRF 60 – 99
- Div 3 PHRF 100 – 174
- Div 7 PHRF 175 – 275
- Martin 242, Multihull, Cruising

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at www.biyrc.bc.ca/ by Wednesday, June 5, 2019

7. THE COURSE

Boats will sail around Bowen Island, in either a clockwise or counter-clockwise direction, as indicated by signals displayed at the start.

8. MEDIA RIGHTS

By participating in the event competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any still or motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the race.

10. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$2 million CAD per incident or the equivalent.
